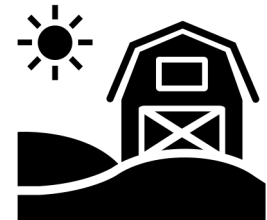

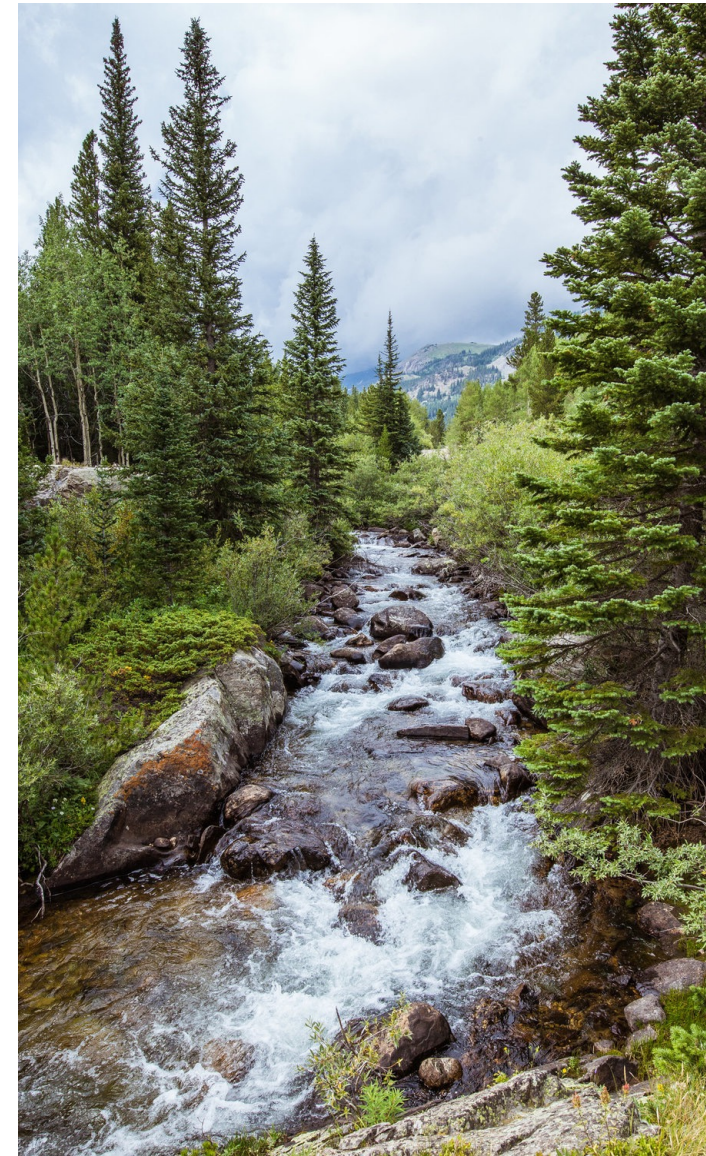

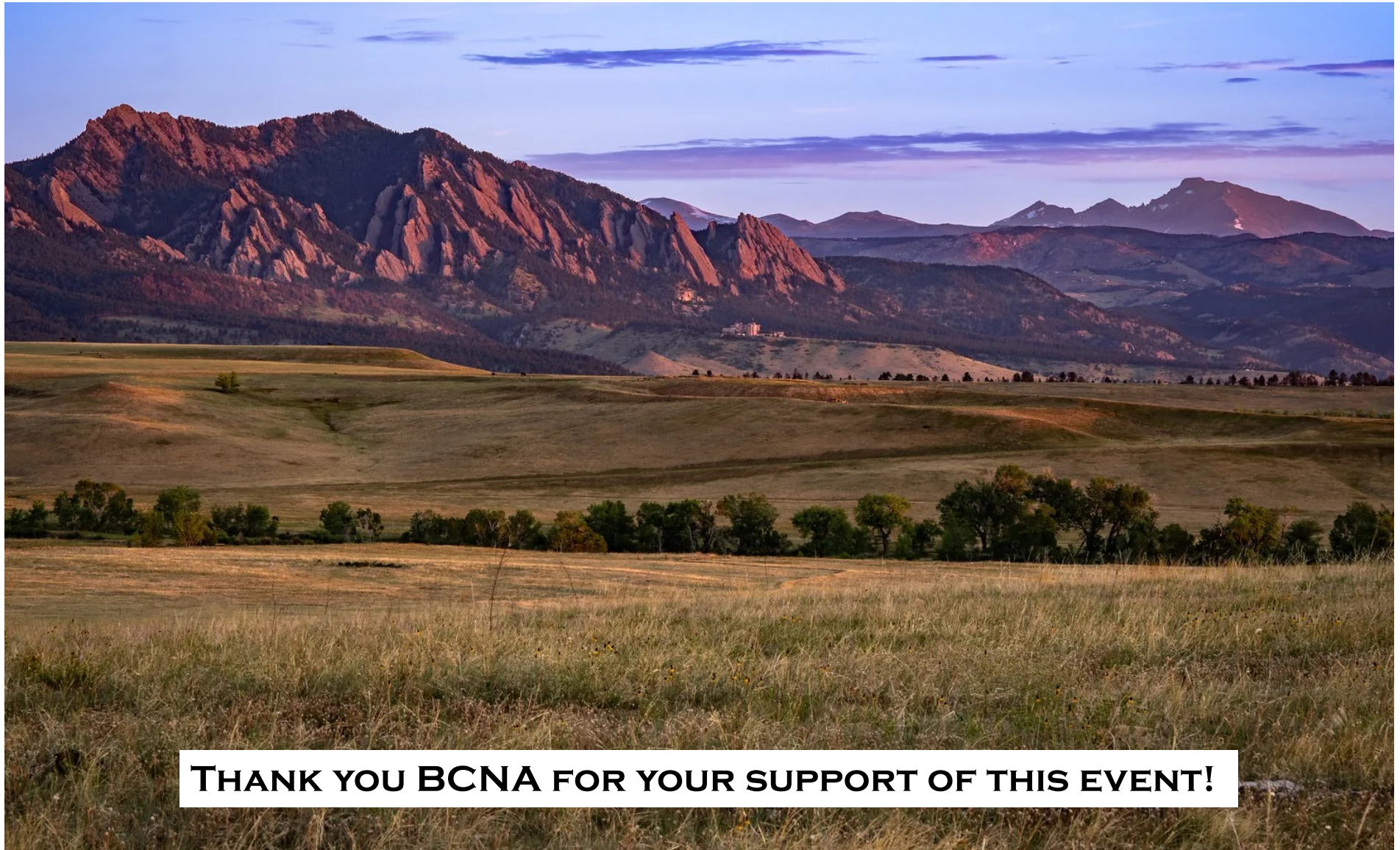


CU Boulder Citizens' Climate Lobby
